The Northamptonshire Energy Efficiency Partnership, made up of all of the local authorities in Northamptonshire, have been working closely with Warmfront to make sure that the elderly and vulnerable in Northamptonshire can stay warm and cosy in their homes.

Dave Malone Home Energy Conservation officer at Daventry District Council said

“I’m delighted that the Warm Front initiative is proving to be such a great success in the County, with hundreds of people benefiting from these grants enabling vulnerable people to keep warm in their homes.”

The NHEEP eco-pixies have been busy arranging loft insulation and cavity wall fills over Northamptonshire. Warmfront representatives are attending the East Midlands EXPO 2007 at Rockingham Speedway on 16<sup>th</sup> October to hand over a cheque for £1,989,753.23 that represents the number of grants awarded across Northampton due to the hard work of the eco-pixies.
